The San Diego City Council will hold a forum to discuss developing a comprehensive water strategy for the region, including whether San Diego should go to a tiered rate pricing structure for water. Panelists will include representatives from the City's Water Department, County Water Authority and Irvine Ranch Water District, which has effectively used tiered pricing to promote conservation. We encourage Coastkeeper supporters to attend this important workshop, which will hopefully be an important step in making San Diego a more sustainable city.

New Port Commissioner from Chula Vista

Former Chula Vista Mayor <u>Steve Padilla was appointed Port Commissioner</u> on Tuesday. Padilla was supported by the environmental community, including Coastkeeper, Environmental Health Coalition and the League of Conservation Voters. In addition to his expected role in guiding the development of Chula Vista's bayfront, he is expected to further green the <u>Port District</u>, which manages San Diego Bay and surrounding waterfront land. The term expires in 2011.


